

Hook Norton Sports and Social Club - Admission Policy and Code of Conduct

HNSSC is a member's only club. Anyone wishing to join can do so via a membership registration form and annual fee. (Ask at bar or on website www.hooknortonsportsandsocialclub.co.uk for details –

Adult sports members have automatic registration into the club.)

Member's names will be displayed on board for 48 hrs before receiving full membership and entitlements.

Anyone wishing to oppose their application can do so during this time period via club secretary (valid reasons only, malicious representations will be void.)

Members are required to sign in. The members signing in book can be found on the bar.

Members may be asked to show their membership card at any time on request.

Members can sign in up to 2 guests each, at any one time. (Individual guests may be signed in up to a max of 6 times per annum)

Members must adhere to clubs rules and policies at all times.

Members are expected to respect other members and the club's property. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave. Constant inappropriate behaviour will result in membership being revoked. Members and visitors are requested that when leaving the premises they do so quickly and quietly to cause little or no disturbance to our neighbours and the residents of Hook Norton. CAR PARKS - cars must be parked in a way that causes the least disturbance to local residents - especially late at night and in a way that does not hinder access or egress for emergency vehicles. Cars are parked at patrons own risk. Outside areas - only areas designated for certain activities should be used. These may vary according to time and sporting fixtures. Appropriate signage indicating these areas will be displayed and adhered to at all times.

Hook Norton Sports & Social Club - Children's Policy

Children will be respected at all times.

HNSSC does not tolerate bullying.

Children are welcome at any time.

Children under 14 years of age will be accompanied by a responsible adult after 9pm.

Children under 8 years of age will be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

Children under 18 will not have access to events that may involve material or contents of an adult nature.

Under 18's will not be sold or supplied with Alcohol (*** with exception of 16.2 of the license act 2003**)

Under 18's will not be sold cigarettes or any other tobacco products.

All person's who have sole access to children shall have CRB checks, first aid qualifications and be familiar with guidelines relating to 'protection of children from harm'.

Coaches and managers of junior sports groups will hold recognised qualifications relevant to that sport.

Children will not have access to gambling machines.

Challenge 21 scheme will be in operation at all times and adult members asked to show membership cards on request.

Hook Norton Sports and Social Club - Drugs and Illegal substances Policy.

HNSSC - HAS A ZERO TOLERANCE TO DRUGS AND OTHER ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

Under no circumstances will Drugs or other illegal substances be permitted on the premises.

People found in possession of Drugs or illegal substances will be asked to leave or be removed from the premises.

Anyone caught dealing in drugs or illegal substances will be reported to the police.

Under 18's will not be served cigarettes or any other tobacco products.

No smoking is permitted anywhere in this building, and under no circumstances.

Smokers must use outside designated smoking areas only.

HNSSC has the right to refuse anyone who appears to be 'drunk' or under the influence of illegal substances.

HNSSC have a duty to ensure that children are always safe on the premises and will seek advice from local authorities if a child appears to be in the care of someone who appears 'drunk' or under the influence of illegal substances.

In the case of junior members, prescribed medicines can only be administered with parental consent or prior parental consent through their clubs First Aid /welfare officer.
